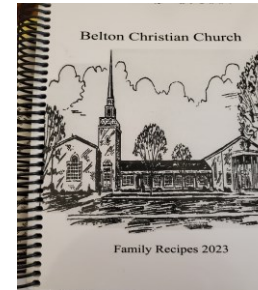

Weekly Zoom Bible Study

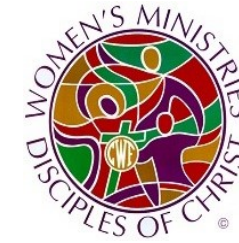

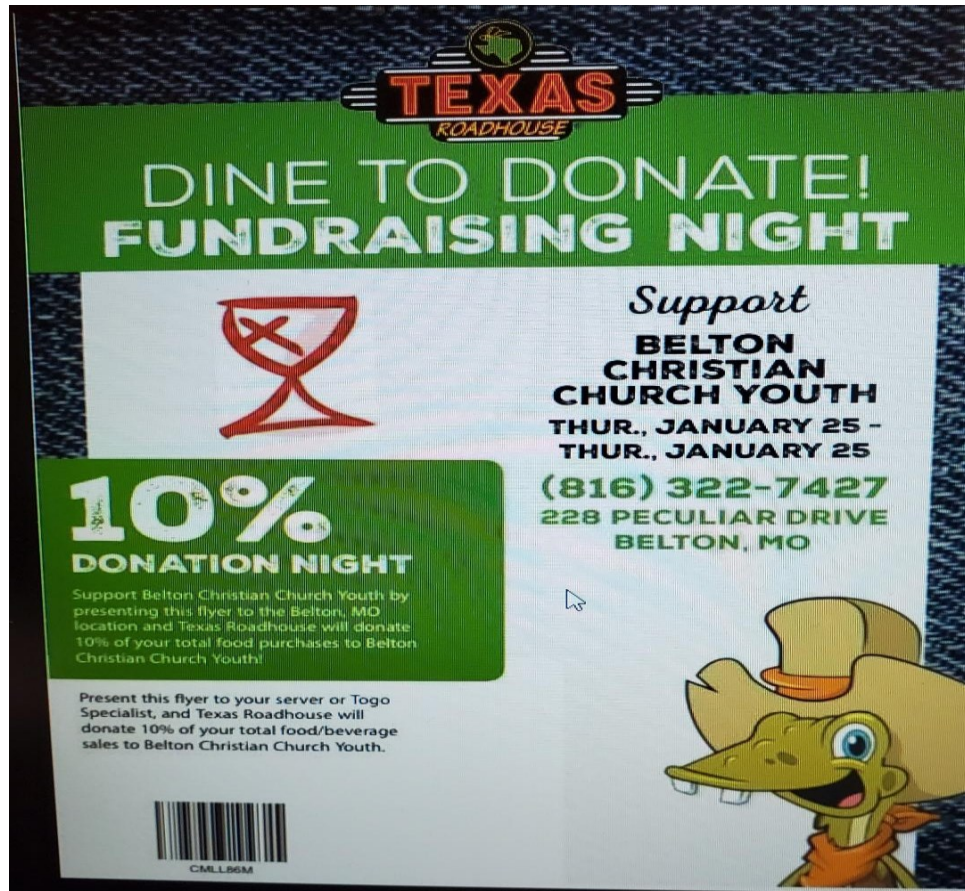
GLADDEN ELEMENTARY
